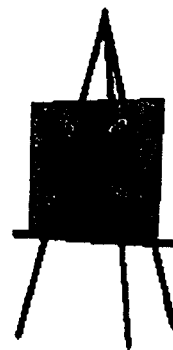

## Art in the Park

On the Village Green, Farmingdale, New York



The Farmingdale Rotary Club, in its ongoing fund raising efforts, will sponsor *Art in the Park* with the support of The Farmingdale Chamber of Commerce.

**Dates:** Weekend - Saturday, September 13th and Sunday, September 14<sup>th</sup>. No rain dates.

**Hours:** From 10.00 AM to 6:00 PM both days.

**Eligibility:** Artists at least 16 years of age to show original works in oils, watercolors, acrylics, pastels, mixed media, drawings, sculpture and photography. Post cards, crafts and commercial type material will not be allowed. The artist must be able to be at their displays throughout the show and set it up on both dates. Those in management of the show will discourage any presentation that is in poor taste. This is not a pre-juried show.

**Entry Fee:** There is a fee of \$50.00 for both days and is not refundable.

**Space:** A 10 foot square space will be provided for each artist. There will be ample room around the spaces that are on the lawn or paved areas. Exhibitors provide their own easels, tables, tents, etc. to display their work. Please avoid showing pieces too large for the space. Electric power will not be available. Artists should expect to stay through the full length of the show. The village office will make facilities available.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded: First, Second and Third plus Honorable Mentions.

**Sales:** Artists may offer to sell their work. We suggest that prices be kept

as reasonable as possible. See sales tax responsibility below.

**Deadline:** Applications must be submitted on or before Monday, August 25, 2008.

**How to apply:** Exhibitors must complete an application that may be downloaded from the Rotary website < [www.farmingdalerotary.org](http://www.farmingdalerotary.org) >. The form may also be obtained from Paul A. Gatto at the art gallery at 300 Main Street during business hours. Return completed and signed applications to the gallery with a check or money order in the amount of \$50.00. Please show in the memo section of your check "Art in the Park" and payable to:

**Responsibilities:**

**Sales Tax:** Each artist selling work is responsible for collecting New York State sales tax. He or she may get additional information by calling in-state (800) 462-8100 or out-of-state (518) 428-8581.

**Protection of art work and property:** Each artist is responsible for their property and property of others and must secure anything left over night. The Rotary is not responsible in the event of loss, damage or personal injury.

The mayor and trustees of the Village are pleased with the onset of events such as these that give the town vitality. The Main Street merchants are being asked to make sidewalk presentations on these show days. We all want to see a successful art show and if successful, be repeated annually
