## PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 16, 2008

President Robert Diaz introduced VP/ Program Chairman Prakash Pisipati who in turn introduced the speaker, Jules Steinhauer, who is an expert in the area of nuclear powered submarines. Mr. Steinhauer was a U.S. Navy submarine officer for 14 years. He is the son-in-law of famed Farmingdale Rotarian Al Meyerstein and a member of the Farmingdale Historical Society. Ben Giminaro arranged this program.. Mr. Steinhauer called the nuclear submarines the U.S. "silent service." Submarines played a big role in World War II with Germany sinking many Allied ships and later with the U.S. submarines sinking many Japanese vessels. The submarines carry long range missiles such as the Tomahawk missile. In the attack on Iraq, many of the missiles were fired from the nuclear submarines. The United States currently has 71 of these submarines. It has been

building one new one per year at a cost of two billion dollars each. There is a proposal to increase production to 2 new nuclear subs per year. Mr. Steinhauer feels this is very necessary because countries like Iran, China and Russia are building a lot of them. Even though Mr. Steinhauer is 82 years old, he is still very active in the Navy War college that meets 3 times a year in Newport, R.I. Frank Bondiotti responded for the Rotary. Frank was in the army artillery and never wanted to be a submariner. (No women aboard). He thanked the speaker for an informative and interesting program

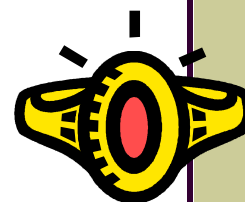
