PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 25, 2009

Vice President John Cuccia ran this meeting. Pres. Prakash Pisipati was in India helping to implement Farmingdale Rotary's water project there. VP Cuccia introduced today's speaker, Marsha Belford of the Brookhaven National Laboratories. Ms. Belford gave an interesting overview of the Lab using slides to illustrate her talk. The Lab was built in 1947. It was originally a military base, Camp Upton. It is owned by the U.S. Dept. of Energy. Some of its educational aspects are coordinated with Stony Brook University. Brookhaven's scientists have garnered 88 Nobel prizes. Their state of the art collider machine helps research about high speed protons (particles). In addition to nuclear physics research, much biological research also takes place at the Lab. For example, Brookhaven discovered that salt aggravates hypertension in humans. Some children's science education takes place at the Lab and there are public tours

of the facility in July and August. As part of the Economic recovery, Brookhaven was granted \$183 million which will add many jobs to Long Island. Scientist Yesh Purandare responded for the Rotary. He thanked the speaker for a thorough overview of the Laboratory.

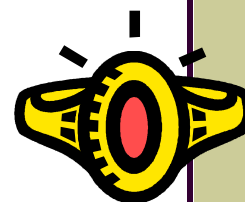
