PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, May 7,2008

President Robert Diaz introduced VP Prakash Pisipati who in turn introduced today's speaker, Dr. Sushil Sagar, who is a doctor of nephrology and professor at Albert Einstein college of medicine. The kidneys clean the blood of chemicals. If the kidneys fail, the quality of a person's blood deteriorates. A blood test measuring your creatinine clearance can indicate whether you have kidney disease. High blood pressure and diabetes can also damage your kidney. Have your blood pressure checked regularly. Keep your weight down. Avoid salty and fatty foods and take your blood pressure medicine if prescribed. In addition to removing waste products from the blood, the kidneys remove excess body water and help control blood pressure. They also assist with hormonal functions. Acute kidney failure is caused by toxins, shock, heart failure, obstruction or trauma. Chronic

kidney failure is caused by kidney stones, cysts, lupus, HIV, diabetes or hypertension. Eric Chimon responded for the Rotary. He praised the speaker for doing a great job explaining kidney disease and believes he is certainly a gifted professor.

Mr. Rolf Rimpo, a German Rotarian, who is a banker, was a guest at this meeting. The week before Rotary hosted a foreign exchange team from the Philippines.
