PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 20, 21009

President Prakash Pisipati introduced today's speaker, long time Rotary member Mike Muchmore who related the interesting story of how his father, Wayne Muchmore, built his successful lumber and box business in Farmingdale. After growing up on a farm in Maine, Wayne Muchmore came to Long Island and obtained a position selling wax. He was a fairly good salesman. During World War II, Republic Airport would burn the wooden crates that the aircraft parts were shipped in. Mr. Muchmore offered to remove the crates free of charge and the airport accepted. This enabled Mr. Muchmore to have a ready source of lumber and nails which he was able to sell to the public. He would also sell wood to box makers but later on started to make the boxes himself. As Long Island grew, so did the demand for lumber and boxes so Mr. Muchmore's business grew accordingly. Though son Mike Muchmore started out as a CPA, he

joined the family business in the 1960's where his cost accounting ability helped in costing the boxes and lumber. Kevin Bagnasco responded for the Rotary. He has known Mike Muchmore a long time and greatly respects how Mike and his father built a terrific business from scratch.
