PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, May 30, 2007

President Ted Firetog conducted the meeting. The speaker was David Sobocinski who is Senior VP of Citigroup Smith Barney. He was assisted by Mark Remigio, Financial Advisor. David pointed out that when social security was first introduced only a small percentage of people lived to be 65 to collect. Now people live much longer, into their 80's and 90's, so retirement planning is much harder. It used to be that when people retired they would put their money in bonds and take 5% a year out for living expenses. Now with people living much longer it's possible to run out of money doing that. David says its necessary to have stocks in one's portfolio. He suggests a minimum of 50 to 60 percent in stocks to provide growth over the years. Further complicating the picture is that inflation can destroy

a retirement plan by eroding its purchasing power over time. The investment portfolio has to allow for inflation and grow to keep pace with the rise in the cost of living. David said that one should take advantage of 401K plans and IRAs which offer tax deferred earnings. Also the 529 college tuition program is a great way to pay college tuitions and allow wealthy people to distribute their estates to their heirs. John Cuccia responded by thanking the speakers for making the Rotary aware of the complications of planning for a financially successful retirement.
