PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, July 11, 2007

This meeting was held at Terry G's on Main Street. Vice President Prakash Pisipati presided because President Diaz was on vacation. Prakash introduced mental health counselor Michael Stolz of the Clubhouse of Suffolk, a mental health rehab center. The Center gets referrals from Suffolk Family Court. Mr. Stolz told the Rotarians that mental illness touches one out of three families. Whereas mental hospitals like Pilgrim State used to house tens of thousands of patients, currently most patients are treated locally in their communities.

Mr. Stolz explained depression, schizophrenia, and bipolar disorder. Schizophrenia is not a split personality but rather is characterized by symptoms such as hallucinations or the corruption of the senses. Being out of contact with reality or obsessive

hoarding are other symptoms of mental illness.

Mentally ill people have above average IQ and are usually not dangerous. Depressed people can harm themselves if they are not treated.

The Clubhouse rehab center seeks to aid the patients through meaningful relationships based on mutual respect and trust. Patients are helped with education, employment and recreational needs.

Gerry Levine responded for the Rotary. Mental health is something we don't hear enough about and Mr. Stolz's group does a fine job with the patients. The phone number of the Clubhouse Rehab is (631) 369-0022. It is at 1380 Roanoke Ave., Riverhead NY
