PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, JULY 30,2008

President Prakash Pisipati introduced VP John Cuccia who presented today's speaker, Past District Governor John Capri. Mr. Capri is chairman of a Rotary District 7250 project called the Anchor Program which seeks to build a building for special needs children in the Town of Hempstead. The children are currently lodged in tents during their six week summer day camp program. There are about 1,000 participants. Mr. Capri, who has a construction background, is attempting to build a 1.5 million dollar building for them at Lido Beach. The land for the project has already been donated by the Town of Hempstead. The Past District Governor would like each Rotary Club in the District to raise about \$5,000. He has many private donors and construction contractors who are willing to donate materials. John's own son is donating the engineering skills. The building will have a gym, a nursing

station, a cafeteria and general purpose rooms. Robert Chapman responded for the Rotary. He praised Mr. Capri's wonderful endeavors and stated how lucky the District was to have him. He wished the speaker good luck and pledged Farmingdale's help with the project.
