PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, August 13, 2008

President Prakash Pisipati introduced VP John Cuccia who presented today's speaker, James Reed, who is the deputy commissioner of the Nassau County Office of Consumer Affairs. Mr. Reed was once awarded the "L.I. Volunteer of The Year" citation. He began by pointing out that stores sometimes charge customers sales taxes on items that are not taxable and that we can obtain lists which explain which items are sales taxable and which ones are not. Mr. Reed then spoke at length about identity theft. The thief may get your information from your mail or from your refuse. The change of address portion of a credit offering may be used by a thief to divert a person's mail to the wrong place. You should not leave your financial data lying about where a household worker or casual entrant to your home can get at your information. As far as pre-approved credit card

applications, you should get your name removed from these lists.

Protect the magnetic strips of your credit cards as they contain key information about you.

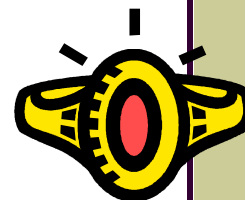
