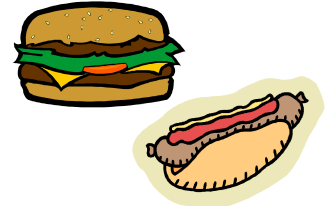
Pat Stickle responded to the presentation thanking, Dr. Glatt for an informative presentation.
