PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 5, 2007

On Sunday, Sept. 16, there will be a District beachfest at Port Washington's Bar Beach from 12-5 PM.

Mr. Hsiao congratulated the Farmingdale Lunch Club for their many successes such as the Salvation Army Bell Ringing & multiple fund raisers.

President Diaz and District Governor Hsiao exchanged presents to close out the meeting on a note of cordiality.

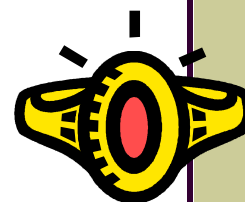
