Helen also was asking the airport for more public information meetings. She felt that Farmingdale citizens were not totally aware of some of the changes at Republic.

Yesh Purandare lives in Farmingdale and expressed some of his concerns about noise and environmental issues. Gerry Levine, who is a licensed pilot, responded for the Rotary and said that people are always nervous about new flight patterns. He hoped that Helen's group's efforts produce the peace of mind that is desired.
