This is a local community group that was formed after the 9/11 terrorist attack that seeks to promote the pride and quality of the Farmingdale Community. Rotarian Tom Sabellico was instrumental in getting the Group started. Farmingdale lost many firefighters and police in the 9/11 so memorials for the fallen were the group's first project. The Group also instituted a reading project whereby one book is chosen to be read by the community and there is then a big discussion of the book at the Farmingdale Library, sometimes with the author present.

There are fundraisers involving sports figures such as the Harlem Globetrotters.

Once a year there is a big Expo at Farmingdale High School where many of the Farmingdale civic groups take booths and explain what Farmingdale is all about. Food and free gifts are sometimes distributed at this function.

The Community Summit has a Family Fund through which needy families may receive some badly needed funds.

Len Constantinopoli responded for the Club. He thanked Mr. Ulric for an excellent presentation about how people can do good for the Farmingdale Community.

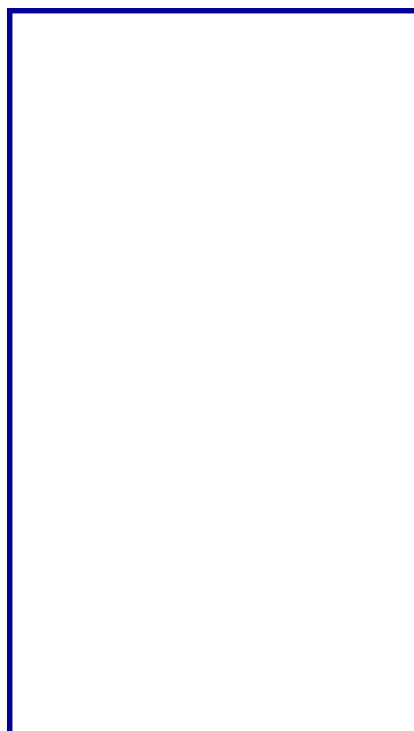
