PROGRAM : MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, NOV. 5, 2008

Rotary President Prakash Pisipati introduced VP John Cuccia who in turn presented today's speaker, Professor Howard Gold of Farmingdale State College. Professor Gold teaches business writing and speaking at the college. He has had articles published by the NY Times and has contributed pieces to many books. Mr. Gold was raised in Farmingdale. He advised the Rotarians to look at their audience when they do public speaking. When using visual aids such as slides or power point, don't just read from the slide but rather use the slide to augment what you are saying. There is a six by six rule which states you should not use more than six slides nor more than six lines per slide. You should use images in your language which help get your message across. When writing a business proposal, you wish to convey authority, trust and motivation to help the customer. Any information

that establishes your credentials such as number of years in business or number of employees is helpful. You should use the correct language and tone and check with your references before you give their name out. Bob Callahan responded for the Rotary. He praised Farmingdale College and the speaker's interesting lecture.
