Jamie has been with YES for 27 years serving the children in Massapequa, Plainedge and Farmingdale communities.

First they opened the doors for the children and their families to address the drug and alcohol problem in the community. After 30 yrs of existence, now there are about 40 full time employees, mostly social workers, with a budget of over \$1 mil.

They organize food drive during the thanks giving time and provide dinner to about 100 needy people.

They have various groups for children, women and adults for anger management, development of self esteem, substance abuse treatment etc.

They help the individual families also.

They run the "Commerce Plaza" project in 3000sft area, which imparts real time experience to 5th grade students in running a business. They partner with various local businesses like Arrow electronics, McDonalds etc.

Jerry Levine responded for the club. He appreciated all the help that is being provided by YES for the local community.

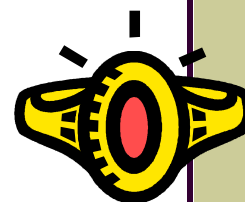
