VP Ted Firetog introduced guest speaker Timothy P. Farrell of US Dept of Homeland Security. Tim is the Principal Liaison to New York Center for Domestic Preparedness, Office of Grants and Training Directorate. www.cdp.dhs.gov. www.ready.gov. John Cuccia invited the guest.

Tim educated the audience with the different methodologies used by the terrorists using the Chemical, Ordnance, Biological and Radiological WMDs. He demonstrated the different types of WMDs and explained their lethal effects.

Center for Domestic Preparedness (CDP) is the only federally chartered WMD training center. CDP offers training on Chemical, Ordnance, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear weapons.

The New York operation is designed to provide direct support from the CDP. Support includes identifying NY area Re-
